BJ'S PROTEST

Lobbyist Richard Lipsky says that five Bronx area supermarkets and the wholesalers at Hunt's Point would be hurt by the construction of a BJ's Warehouse on Bruckner Boulevard. He is rallying 100 or so union members and small business owners to appear at the city Planning Commission's next meeting to protest the 130,000-square-foot store, which would be built by The Related Cos. The Planning Commission held a hearing on the project last week, but a miscommunication on the time thwarted opponents' efforts to be heard, Mr. Lipsky says. A Planning Commission spokeswoman says the project does not meet the thresholds to trigger a socioeconomic study of its impact on the neighborhood.
